



Handouts 2-5: Project Summaries Coversheet

For review at 4 December 2012, Coordinating Committee Meeting

The attached tables provide summaries of the original projects submitted in October 2012 as well as the revised/added projects from November 2012 for a total of 141 total project submittals for the Westside region. Each of the projects was scored based on the information provided in the project application document. In addition, a preliminary urgency and importance was assigned to each project based on the urgency and importance of the primary objective(s) (Refer to Handout 3) that the project is designed to help satisfy.

The tables that follow are then sorted based on:

- The lead agency/organization, then by project type
- By importance, then by urgency
- By similar projects in accordance with the primary objective that the project is intended to help satisfy – this will help facilitate collaboration and coordination amongst stakeholders for projects that meet the same or similar objectives

What we ask of you:

As you review these sorted project tables please consider the following:

- Is the assigned urgency and importance appropriate for your project?
- If you submitted multiple projects and they received similar importance and urgency ratings based on a shared objective, would you like to emphasize the importance or urgency of some of your projects over others that you submitted?
- Are there any project submittals that you think should be moved to a “potential future projects” category in order to focus implementation efforts by reducing the number of prioritized projects included in the IRWM Plan?
- Are there any projects submitted that should not be included in the Westside IRWM Plan?

Please be prepared to discuss and respond to these questions during the December 13 and 18, 2012 stakeholder meetings.
