The Westside Sacramento Integrated Regional Water Management Coordinating Committee (CC) is pleased to submit this letter in support of the County Service Area (CSA-2), Spring Valley Lake Restoration Project (Project) for funding consideration. The project provides reliable water supply to a rural disadvantaged community. CSA-2 is owned by the County of Lake and operated by the county water district. The WaterSmart funding will be used to improve local domestic water supply reliability for a community with limited options for a secondary water supply. CSA-2 relies solely on one single surface water supply, increasing the community's water scarcity risk. This project will provide a backup source to deliver greater water supply reliability in the face of shifts in weather patterns towards shorter winters and prolonged dry seasons, increased drought frequency, and declining groundwater levels, which threaten the water supply for domestic users.

This important project builds on strong resiliency-driven regional and local community efforts to enhance water supply reliability. It will ensure safe, sanitary water for households in the Spring Valley Community. Enhancement of the lake will provide the local community with a reliable domestic water supply.

The CC prioritized the Spring Valley Lake Restoration project for funding through California's Department of Water Resources and is committed to assisting this effort to build drought resiliency through water supply reliability.

The Westside Sacramento IRWM Coordinating Committee wholeheartedly supports this project, and we thank you for your funding consideration.
